Robert Facchina

Robert A. Facchina is an outstanding entrepreneur, philanthropist and humanitarian who is motivated by a strong work ethic and innovative spirit. In 1987 Mr. Facchina had a life altering experience having been diagnosed with advanced stage metastatic malignant melanoma. Robert's pragmatic pursuit of a cure put him on a dynamic path characterized by creative based solutions whether in life, commerce, non-profit or fundamental research.

Mr. Facchina founded the National Immunotherapy Cancer Research Foundation in 1990 and later Curevax LLC. The NICRF is now a public charity providing funding for immunotherapy cancer research, patient education and support. For nearly 10 years he heavily invested in Curevax doing fundamental research to develop human cancer vaccines. Robert for many years provided counseling services to advanced stage cancer patients focusing on treatment options including alternative modalities such as immunotherapy.

Mr. Facchina is President, CEO and owner of Johanna Companies established through the acquisitions of Johanna Dairies in 1995, Olympic Foods in 2007 and the start-up of Pantera Logistics also in 2007. Johanna Companies employ about 700 people providing national manufacturing and logistical services to a multitude of retail customers and national brands. The companies also market their own brands; La Yogurt, Tree-Ripe, Earthwise, Ssips and Sabor Latino.

For his contributions to Italian culture, philanthropy and humanitarian activities, Mr. Facchina was knighted in 2013 by former President of Italy, Georgio Napolitano in recognition for exceptional service to the Italian Republic. Mr. Facchina is Commendatore Ordine al Merito della Repubblica Italiana (Commander Order of Merit of the Italian Republic).
